Jordan Perry is a Saskatchewan-based producer, songwriter, and drummer whose music exists at the intersection of retro-futuristic synth-pop, modern electronic production, and expressive acoustic drums. A Canadian Independent Music Award-nominated artist, Perry has developed a distinctive sound shaped by his parallel career as a sought-after session drummer and producer. His wide-ranging musical background - spanning pop, rock, electronic, hiphop, neo-soul, afrobeat, country, and metal - feeds into songs that feel rhythmically alive while remaining focused on mood, melody, and feeling.

Perry's upcoming release, *Jeux d'hiver*, is rooted in the idea of winter as both environment and emotional state. Growing up and working on the Canadian prairies, winter is unavoidable: a season that slows life down, sharpens introspection, and forces adaptation. Rather than treating it as a backdrop, Perry uses winter as a unifying concept - one that informs the pacing, textures, and emotional weight of the music. Themes of isolation, quiet perseverance, and fleeting warmth run throughout the project.

The lead single, "Sleep Forever," ft. Celin serves as an entry point into this world. Driving and desperate, Perry portrays a man overwhelmed by depression, while Celin's warm voice offers a steady, grounding counterpoint.
